A selection of the Inventors children took part in a Tarka Tennis Tournament on Wednesday, showing tremendous determination against the other schools. Yesterday a team of 12 competed in a South Molton Community College athletics event coming 4th overall. A great effort all-round.

On Monday Virgin Care will be in school to deliver the children's annual Flu Vaccination. Only those children whose parents have consented to the vaccine will receive it. Each child will bring home a proof of vaccination certificate. There is still time make your voluntary contribution towards Theatre Alibi's production of 'I Believe in Unicorns', taking place next Thursday in the Jubilee Hall for the whole school. The Adventurers and Discoverers have been busy rehearsing for their Nativity performance, which will take place on Wednesday 11th December at 10am in the Jubilee Hall. All parents, grandparents and family friends of the children performing are welcome to attend. As we have to hire the hall for our rehearsals and performances, we ask for a contribution on the door from all who come to watch to help us meet the costs incurred. Our PTFA have arranged to provide refreshments in the hall from 8.40am, so you can have a brew and wait in the warm before the performance begins. After the Nativity there will be a cake sale for friends and family as well as the children so we welcome any cake contributions on the day.

Our whole school Christmas Service will be taking place at St James Church on Friday 13th December at 2pm and all are welcome to attend. As the service is taking place in the afternoon, all children will be dismissed from the church. Your child will have all their belongings with them, so please ensure you have arranged for your child to be collected from the church by 3.15pm. Many thanks in advance.

Don't forget that on Wednesday 18th December, the children will be sitting down to enjoy our whole school Christmas lunch. As this is an extra special lunch, we are requesting an additional 25p per child to cover the costs. We would therefore ask that you drop 25p in a named envelope, into the school office as soon as possible, so that numbers can be counted. To really get into the festive spirit, children can choose to come into school in a Christmas jumper and/or Christmas hat, for a donation of £1 which will go towards our sponsorship of Mamadou - our Action Aid child.

To round off this special festive day, we are also going to be carol singing around Swimbridge Village from 6-8pm, ending with hot chocolate at The Jack Russell from 7.45pm. All are welcome to join us, however, we do ask that parents accompany their own children. Please meet at school, wrapped up warm, no later than 5.50pm, ready to start promptly at 6pm.
