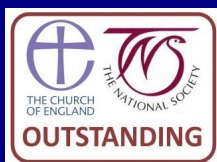

Some of our learning this week:

Adventurers have enjoyed making split-pin sea creatures for their puppet show next week.

Discoverers have been looking at David Attenborough's work on Blue Planet 2 to learn about plastic pollution.

Explorers have been creating tropical masks to use in their rainforest dance at the end of term. They have also planned their rainforest café activities ready for next week.

Inventors have been busy rehearsing for the summer production and the set is starting to take shape.

Thursday this week was our 'Move up Morning', where the children had an opportunity to spend time in their new (September) classes. We welcomed our new Reception children for a taster morning in Adventurers and our year 6's spent the day at their new secondary schools. An enjoyable morning was had by all!

Pupil reports were sent home at the beginning of this week to provide you with a comprehensive account of your child's learning behaviour, progress and attainment this academic year. Please book a parents consultation appointment with your child's class teacher on the sign up sheets outside school, if you would like to discuss any aspect of your child's learning.

The KS2 production of The Jungle Book is really starting to take shape. The children are working extremely hard making the stage set, props and costumes as well as rehearsing at every opportunity. Don't forget you can purchase your tickets either from the sales desk at the front of school, or via the school office. To make things as fair as possible, every KS2 family is initially able to purchase up to 3 tickets per performance (6 overall). If the allocated tickets are not needed by a family and are left unsold, these spare tickets will then become available on a first-come-first-served basis for anyone to purchase. All tickets are £2.50.

On Friday 13th July, the day of the evening production, the Inventors will need to stay in school from 3.15pm until the start of the performance to make sure that the set, costumes and make-up are in place in time for 6pm—'curtain up'. Each child will be asked (nearer the time) to bring in an item for a 'bring-&-share' tea in the hall.

The Inventors are in need of large torches as part of the lighting for the production. Please see Mrs King if you have any that we could borrow.

A letter has gone home today about our activities week; taking place from Monday 16th to Friday 20th July. To help us to ensure the week runs smoothly, please make sure that your child comes to school with all the equipment needed for the various activities and complete and return the permission form for Collard Bridge as soon as possible. Many thanks for your support with this.

Please continue to collect and bring into school any clean recycling, particularly plastic packaging; coloured bottles; bottle tops; bubble wrap; bags and polythene, to help us with our sea creature sculpture work during activities week. Parents are also very welcome to come in and help with this project on Thursday 19th July, so please pop to the office if you are available.
